**49 Total Credits (2.0 GPA)**

\*\* Core 40 and Academic Honors Diplomas (AHD) require Biology and Physics/Chemistry/ICP in science and Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II in mathematics.  
AHD additionally requires Chemistry OR Physics in science.

Students must take a quantitative reasoning course each year in high school.

Students must have 6 credits of math while in high school.

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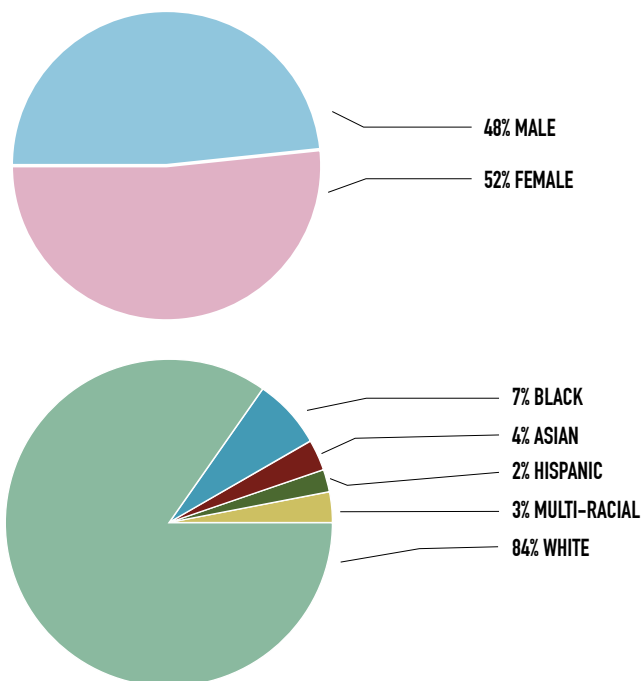

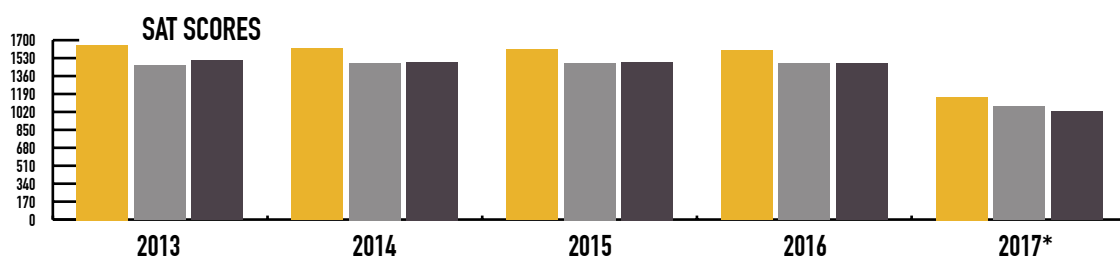
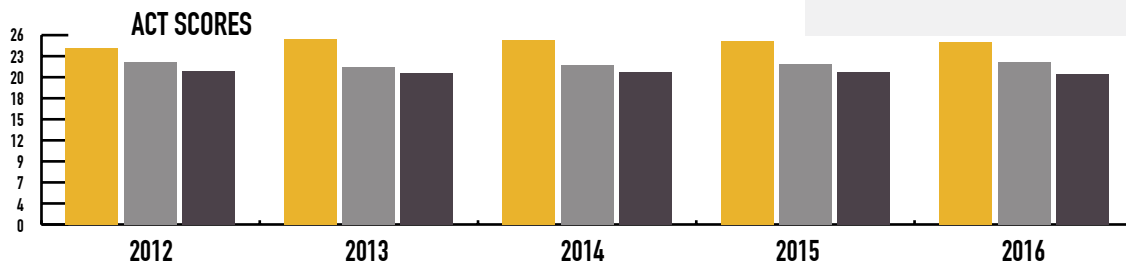
